



Storiez is Looking for a Program Intern!

Storiez is a trauma-informed program created to help inner city youth and others who have had difficult life experiences to create, voice, and honor their narratives. Storiez provides training and resources to trauma survivors, therapists, teachers, parents, and other community leaders. Storiez also partners with the community in helping trauma survivors pull from their inner strengths to overcome life challenges. It supports people as they answer the questions: “Where have I been? Where am I now? Where do I want to be?”

Storiez is recruiting for its first Program Intern in an effort to expand the program’s capacity to hold more trainings, deliver more resources, and help more people. The intern’s position will mainly involve developing partnerships with service providers, funders, and the community at large. The position will involve 15-20 hours a week, ideally over a school year (two semesters). The position is unpaid, although the work may be eligible for school credit.

Responsibilities

- Represent Storiez at community events to increase visibility and engagement
- Identify community organizations to partner with for provision of training and resources
- Foster and develop relationships with organizations servicing the trauma community during networking events
- Follow up with organizations regarding training dates, agreements, and training fees
- Provide support for community trainings including preparation of training packets, grading of post-tests, and scoring of instructor evaluations
- Assist in applications for CEU and ACT credits; ensure fulfillment of requirements by accrediting bodies
- Identify potential conference opportunities and speaking engagements
- Identify and pursue potential funding opportunities
- Promote trainings and special events through social media, e-mail, and snail mail
- Update website periodically
- Other duties as assigned

Qualifications

- Enrollment in an undergraduate or graduate program at an accredited college or university
- Interest in social work, psychology, sociology, or related field
- Experience with trauma-informed approaches a plus
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Organized and detail-oriented
- Knowledge of Philadelphia neighborhoods, schools, and/or nonprofit landscape
- Self-starter, with an ability to solve problems creatively
